We are excitedly making plans for our Conference-wide Fall Bible Camp. This letter is to let you know how we can work together to create an outstanding experience for our youth (grades 9-12) with God. We encourage you to pray for and make promoting this Bible Camp a priority.

Please see that this letter is copied and shared with your sponsors who will be attending. It contains the information needed to help everyone be prepared for the weekend.

DATES: Thursday, September 20 – Sunday, September 23, 2018

THEME: "God is, You are, We can"

<u>The purpose of Fall Bible Camp</u> is to create opportunities in an interactive atmosphere where young people will experience God and invite Him to shape and mold their lives and lifestyles.

<u>The focus of Fall Bible Camp</u> is to inspire discipleship - what it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ and how this impacts daily decisions and choices.

We are hosting Fall Bible Camp at Washington Family Ranch – a place that provides opportunities for activities from the simple to the extreme (see below for more details)

STUDENTS: All students attending Fall Bible Camp must be in 9th-12th grade – there will be no exception. Home school students' grade level is determined by the grade level of the majority of their classes.

SPONSORS: We **MUST** have a sponsor for every 8 students. Please make sure you have adequate staff. We need to have both male and female sponsors with your group so that they will be able to give leadership and supervision in both the guy's and girl's lodge rooms. Their example will encourage the young people. Washington Family Ranch will be collecting money from us for all sponsors. Sponsors will need to pay unless your group has arranged to pay for them.

INTERNET USAGE:

In an ongoing effort to supply the bible camp program team with the tools that they need AND accommodate sponsors with connection to the outside world that they may need, this year we will be setting up an "Internet Café" in the Hotel Lobby. Sponsors <u>only</u> will be able to go to this place to connect, should they have that need. Unfortunately, due to the remote location of WFR, bandwidth is at a premium and the programming needs of the bible camp programing team **must** take precedence. Please come, but be prepared to take a (mostly) digital fast for the three days of Bible camp. Pay Phones are available for use by all, as well.

GUIDELINES / RULES: Sponsors will be expected to manage the following items:

- Collect & bring the Guest Consent Release Forms of all students & staff to be turned in at registration
- Collect & bring Permission Medical Consent forms for all students
- Sponsors will be assigned to sleep in the same rooms as their students
- Assist in the group activities
- Guys not permitted in girls lodging areas
- Girls not permitted in guys lodging areas
- Monitoring curfews and quiet times
- No PDAs (Public Displays of Affection such as hand-holding, arms around each other, etc.)
- Swimsuit monitoring of their students (see WHAT TO BRING list below)
- WHAT NOT TO BRING list (below)

KITCHEN WORKERS: Your group is required to bring 1 Kitchen Worker for every 10 people (not 1 for every 10 students but 1 for every 10 people).

Kitchen Workers must be adults at least 18 years old. The Registration Fee is waived because Kitchen Workers do not have time to participate in the activities or meetings. Their responsibilities include meal preparation, meal serving, and meal clean-up. This takes most of the day. Washington Family Ranch's kitchen staff and chefs will supervise and provide all the necessary training. A training session will start at 8 PM on Thursday evening so Kitchen Workers NEED TO BE AT CAMP BY THAT TIME. Washington Family Ranch will not allow switching among sponsors on this task. Each youth group should recruit people to come for this team according to the ratio above with a minimum of one person. This would be people that support the youth and youth ministry of their church, approved through their conference as volunteers to work with minors, but are not coming as a sponsor/chaperone. This could be parents. A full Kitchen Work Crew is required, therefore these people are invaluable to our Bible Camp.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$190 (+\$10.00 for offering) Bible Camp Fee (For students and sponsors)

\$0 Kitchen Worker Fee

Travel costs are not included and must be paid to the church or school providing transportation. We strongly encourage youth groups to seek donations and do fundraisers to help support those that are not able to attend because of the cost.

<u>Please Note:</u> Like we did last year... during our Sabbath morning worship service the students will be given an opportunity to give to a specific ministry.

TRANSPORTATION: It is expected that each group will arrange for and cover their travel expenses.

DEVOTIONS: Each student and sponsor should bring a Bible for devotions, meetings, and Cabin Time.

RECREATION: Thursday night, Friday, and Saturday night have been reserved for recreation. Plan on bringing appropriate clothing for the following activities: high-ropes course, zip line, swimming,

paddle boarding, basketball, volleyball, dodge ball, rock climbing wall, soccer, skateboard/inline skate park, hiking, 5K fun run, exercise equipment, foosball, ping pong, disc golf and Octo-ball.

FOOD: We will enjoy great cooking from the Washington Family Ranch. All meals will be vegetarian. If someone has special dietary needs, please let us know at registration. PLEASE NOTE THIS Continuing CHANGE: NO MEAL IS PROVIDED by WFR THURSDAY EVENING Your group should eat prior to arrival. The Youth department is willing to provide a Pizza Feed in Madras Thursday afternoon. Schools interested should contact Pastor Randy at the office to work out the logistics.

SECURITY: We are unable to provide security patrols to enforce curfews and insure general security of the facility. We ask that sponsors cooperate with us in encouraging participants to follow the schedule and not participate in any destructive behavior.

SABBATH: Sabbath is the best day of the week and we are planning to make sure that it is just that. There will be a number of Sabbath afternoon indoor and outdoor activities!

EXPRESSION SESSION: We all enjoy the students sharing the various gifts that God has blessed them with. The process of involving our youth in this program is a nomination system. As a youth leader at your church or school you know the students you can recommend and who will be ready for the chance to share for this program. Only those who have been recommended by a school or church youth leader will be considered. We trust you to screen these performances for appropriateness and quality. This program will be organized at Bible Camp. Be sure to have students bring their instruments.

Our hope is to accommodate as many of the students and groups as possible.

SCHEDULE: (see enclosed Preliminary Schedule)

WHAT TO BRING: In all decisions regarding "what to bring" please keep appropriate Christian behavior and modesty in mind.

- Guest Consent Release Form (Young Life's form) for all persons attending regardless of age.
- Permission Medical Consent Form for all students under 18 years of age
- Casual clothes, recreation clothes, (Sabbath will be casual).
- Modest 1-piece swimsuit (Speedos or bikinis are not allowed)
- Bible, notebook, pen
- Sleeping bag, pillow
- Towel, soap, shampoo, toiletries
- Name tags on all your luggage so it can be identified when you get to camp.
- \$10.00 offering
- Instruments and other supplies needed for "Expression Session"
- A friend or two

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Personal music devices we want to encourage interaction
- Jewelry and other valuables
- Knives, firearms, drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, fireworks
- Other obviously unwanted stuff

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: We must have your Registration List of attendees, listed by names of boys & girls, male & female Sponsors, and Kitchen Workers in our office by September 7. This is required by Washington Family Ranch for food planning the housing assignments. We can make small adjustments and possible additions until September 11 by contacting Desiree (503)-850-3521.
